



Lake Burton

November 1, 2017 – starts **down** to 7 feet below normal pool

February 1, 2018 – starts up...

March 1, 2018 – within 5 feet of Normal pool

May 1, 2018 – Normal summer pool

Seed Lake

January 2, 2018 – starts **down** to 12 feet below normal pool

January 28, 2018 – starts up

February 4, 2018 – back to normal pool

Lake Rabun

November 26, 2017 – starts **down** to 10 feet below normal pool

December 24, 2017 – starts up

December 28, 2017 – back to normal pool

Tallulah Falls Lake

February 4, 2018 -starts **down** to 7 feet below normal pool

February 11, 2018 – starts up

February 12, 2018 – back to normal pool

NOTE: Georgia Power Company has made a new change in operations of how they manage the frequency of the lake drawdowns on our North Georgia lakes. This change will now require the North Georgia Lakes which includes Lake Burton, Seed Lake, Lake Rabun and Tallulah Falls Lake to move to a drawdown schedule that will occur once every three years.

As a part of this change, Georgia Power Company will schedule routine maintenance requirements on dams to coincide with the three-year drawdown frequency for the North Georgia Lakes. Please note if GPC has a situation where work needs to be performed outside of this schedule they would notify you of that situation and the schedule for the lake to be drawn down. This will allow you to work on your lake structures while the lake level is lower.
